- Bullying is erosive to the team spirit.






What is Bullying

- **Emotional/Social** being unfriendly, excluding or intentionally ignoring someone
- **Physical** pushing, kicking, hitting, punching or any use of violence, material damage of equipment and clothing
- Racial racial taunts, gestures, pictures or other slurs
- Sexual unwanted physical contact or sexually abusive comments, homophobic remarks or focusing on the issue of sexuality
- **Verbal** name-calling, sarcasm, spreading rumors, teasing, threatening to cause harm, taunting or tormenting
- Cyber any form of cyberbullying social media posting, texts, emails, messages etc. - that are corresponding to the forms of bullying mentioned above





Raise the flag!

Consequences of Bullying

- Suspension from the club activities
- Exclusion from the club
- Report to the authorities
- Mitchell Miller story:
 - High-end athlete since young age
 - At age of 14 (2016) accused and convicted of bullying his classmate
 - Drafted to NHL(Arizona, 2020) but rights were relinquished by drafted team
 - Recently signed NHL contract (Boston) contract terminated 2 days after signed
 - NHL players refused to accept him
 - According to the NHL statement: is not eligible to play in the NHL!
